### PRAISE AND CONCERNS:

**In July**, the Rosthern Ministerial asks us to pray for the Seventh Day Adventist congregation, and for the Rosthern Refugee Committee. In August, please pray for Trinity Lutheran Church.

#### Prayer requests from Mennonite Church Canada:

In the wake of the terrible violence unfolding in Gaza and in Israel, we, as a historic Peace Church deeply lament the military action which has devastated so many lives. We lament that organized violence has again caused such destruction and death in this contested region. As of July 22 reports indicate that around 600 Palestinians and around 27 Israeli soldiers have already been killed in this war. UNRAWA, the UN agency for Palestinian refugees, reports that over 118,000 people have been displaced and are seeking refuge.

Please continue to pray for an immediate end to the conflict in Gaza and the military aggression from both sides. Pray for the many people of Gaza and Israel whose lives have been devastated by military action. Pray for leaders of Israel, Palestine, and also our Canadian leaders, that they would seek diplomatic solutions that could lead to a lasting peace and reconciliation without the domination of one side over the other.

Although Mennonite Church Canada does not have ministry partners in Gaza, we have been planning with Bethlehem Bible College (BBC) to send Palmer Becker (Waterloo North Mennonite Church, ON) on a short-term assignment to Gaza in September, 2014 to teach a course on pastoral care there. Given the uncertainties of the current conflict, we are consulting with BBC leaders about this assignment. Mennonite Church Canada staff are also consulting with BBC leaders, and with senior MC Canada staff, about how best to respond or advocate for an end to military action in Gaza. Thank you for your prayers.

# ANNOUNCEMENTS:


