This communication is going out to all MC Sask congregations <u>requesting</u> <u>approval for a personal care home extension project</u> at the Mennonite Nursing home in Rosthern.

At the last MC Saskatchewan Annual Delegate Session, the delegates passed a motion giving approval for the Mennonite Nursing Home Board to proceed with the planning of a personal care home extension at the Mennonite Nursing Home in Rosthern.

The plans have proceeded rapidly, and the Mennonite Nursing Home Board is now requesting approval for the project. The MNH Board is excited about the way plans have come together.

Attached is a brochure outlining the project. Board member phone numbers are listed on the back, if more information is required.

The funds for this project will be solicited by the Mennonite Nursing Home Board. Mennonite Church Saskatchewan is not being asked to contribute to this.

The MC Sask Council will give the approval for this project, if the majority response from MC Sask congregations is positive.

MC Sask Council is asking for a response from all congregations by **December 15 2014.** The response requested is: are you or are you not in favour of allowing this project to proceed?
