God moves...past All Obstacles Luke 13:31-35

Group Lectio Divina using Luke 13:31-35

### **Jesus' Sorrow for Jerusalem**

<sup>31</sup> At that time some Pharisees came to Jesus and said to him, “Leave this place and go somewhere else. Herod wants to kill you.”

<sup>32</sup> He replied, “Go tell that fox, ‘I will keep on driving out demons and healing people today and tomorrow, and on the third day I will reach my goal.’ <sup>33</sup> In any case, I must press on today and tomorrow and the next day—for surely no prophet can die outside Jerusalem!

<sup>34</sup> “Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you were not willing. <sup>35</sup> Look, your house is left to you desolate. I tell you, you will not see me again until you say, ‘Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.’”<sup>[a]</sup>

## **GROUP LECTIO DIVINA**

### **Preparation**

Sit quietly for a few minutes in the presence of God.

Prepare to read the passage slowly and reflectively.

#### **1. Hear the Word**

- Read a short passage from the scripture.
- Listen attentively for a particular word or phrase that seems to be given for you.
- Speak aloud the word received.

#### **2. Ask “How is my life touched?”**

- Read the same passage a second time.
- In silence ponder how the passage seems to touch your life.
- Briefly speak aloud your sense of being touched.

#### **3. Ask “Is there an invitation here?”**

- Read the passage a third time.
- In silence reflect on a possible invitation to you in the passage.
- Speak aloud the invitation you have received.

#### **4. Pray for one another**

- Pray for the person to your right to be empowered to do or be what he or she feels called to do or be.

#### **5. Sharing**

- How did you experience this group meditation?
- As you think about it now, how was God in this experience with you?
