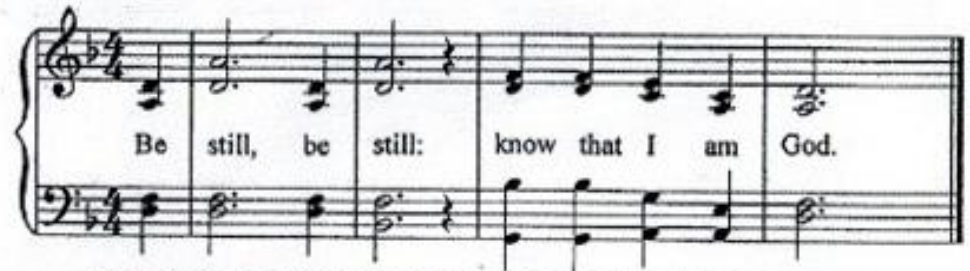

THE EXAMEN

1. Light a candle,
