It is a Challenge!

The Good Samaritan Club is setting out a challenge to the people of Rosthern Mennonite Church to prepare 50 (or more!) school kits for MCC by March 22.


MCC School Kits are a frequently requested item. Notebooks and pencils are treasures for families who struggle to afford basic school supplies. School kits often are requested after disasters and help bring normalcy to children whose families have been forced to flee their homes. 78,035 kits were shipped last year to Jordan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Iraq, Zambia, Ukraine, Somalia, Burkina Faso, Canada, the U.S.

Each Kit needs:

- 4 spiral notebooks (140 pages) or 7 80-page notebooks
- 8 unsharpened pencils
- 12 coloured pencils in original packaging
- 1 large pencil eraser
- 1 flat flexible ruler
- 2 black or blue ballpoint pens
- 1 small all-metal pencil sharpener

All items need to be new.

Please place your items in the blue container in the foyer.



All items and money must be in by March 22, and the kits will be assembled on March 29 during our coffee hour after church.

In February, the Rosthern Ministerial Association asks us to pray for the Living Faith Pentecostal Church, and for the World Day of Prayer, coming up on March 6.

Prayer requests from Mennonite Church Saskatchewan:

Mary Hope Wood Stucky, one of the first mission workers to Colombia, died Feb. 8 at the age of 103 in Bogotá, Colombia, leaving a legacy of mission work spanning 75 years. Alix Lozano, retired director of Seminario Bíblico Menonita de Colombia in a tribute to Mary Hope, said, "... you are a woman whose presence reminds us ... that we are a church with a past and a present that we hold on to for the future, a church that must bequeath future generations with challenges and commitments." Let us keep the family of one of our original International Witness Workers in our prayers.

Africa Inter-Mennonite Mission (AIMM) asks us to pray that God restores peace to the continually deteriorating security situation in Burkina Faso. Thousands of people have been displaced by increasingly frequent, violent attacks by radical Islamic terrorist groups. These attacks target mosques, churches, schools and government military and police outposts. Pray for courage and trust for leaders and members of the Evangelical Mennonite Church in this challenging environment. Pray for acts of love between Christians and Muslims that show a better way forward.

"God loves you and is walking with us through this difficult time." This is the message that Christians in Wuhan, China, are giving to people as they provide much needed face masks to people in their communities. Please continue to pray for those affected by this epidemic. Pray that believers in China will be able to share the reason for their hope in a dark time. Pray for wisdom as plans are made for Mennonite workers in China in the next few months.
